IT'S EASY (AND FREE!) TO SIGN UP:

1. Register to run or walk at oldbills.org.
2. Registration is free! Advance registration is encouraged.
3. Runners who wish to be timed must register by Friday, Sept 6 at 5pm.
4. Timed runner bibs are available for pickup at the Community Foundation (245 E. Simpson Ave.) on Sept 3-6 from 9am-5pm; or at Jackson Elementary School Field on Run Day, Sept 7 from 8-9am.
5. On Run Day, the start gun fires at 9am sharp.
6. The top three male and female adult and youth runners in the timed 5K and 10K win cash to donate to their favorite participating nonprofits.

For safety, bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, and other wheeled transportation are prohibited. Only walkers, runners, strollers, and wheelchairs are allowed.

Dogs that are well-behaved in crowds are welcome. They must be kept on a short leash and picked up after.

WHEN: Saturday, Sept 7 at 9am
WHERE: The race starts and finishes at Jackson Elementary School Field on Willow Street. The route goes through East Jackson to the National Elk Refuge and back.

WHAT: Explore the booths and learn about local nonprofits in the Nonprofit Village, and celebrate philanthropy.
